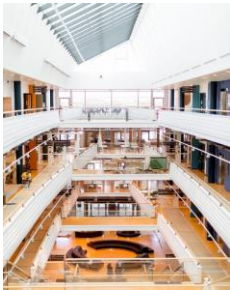


Uppsala University was founded in 1477 and is the oldest university in the Nordic countries. About 40,000 students study at the university. Several world-famous scientists have been scholars at Uppsala University, such as Carl Linnaeus (left), Anders Celsius, Svante Arrhenius and Anders Jonas Ångström.

Uppsala is Sweden's 4th largest city, located 40 minutes north of Stockholm. Uppsala has been an important cultural and religious centre since the 11th century. King Gustaf Vasa (1523-1560) built a strategic fortress here, known today as Uppsala Castle, the location for the congress dinner.

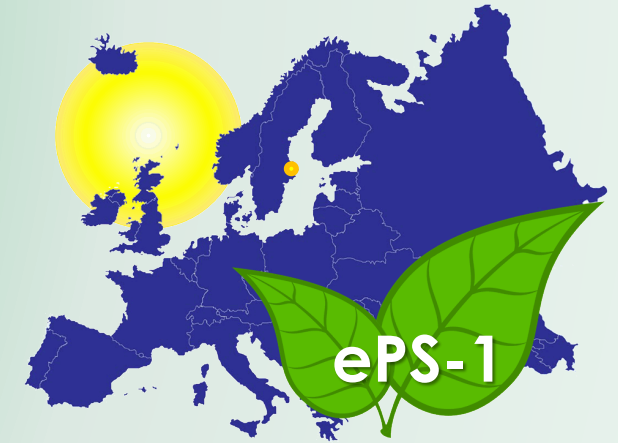

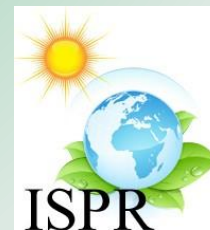
